

Case study 6:

As a part of the national measles elimination campaign The Ministry of Health, Harmonia decided to conduct a mass immunization campaign for all children 9 months up to 15 years of age on **1 March 2016**. Parents were asked to bring their children to the nearest health centre for MR vaccination.

At the Platinum Primary School, consent forms were sent to parents of all eligible children. The school based immunization was carried out in the morning of 1 March 2016. 137 children were vaccinated in the school without any incident. 8 children of class 1 missed the vaccination as they went to an audition. In the afternoon, the school headmistress instructed Ms Pearl, the school nurse to take 8 children to the Primary Health Unit Platinum to get vaccinated.

Ms Pearl took the children to Primary Health Unit Platinum, located at Aries Street, Province Yellow for the MR vaccine. The vaccine was administered by Ms Sadhna a new vaccinator between 2.15 and 3,15 pm. The details of the vaccine and the diluent are given below

One of the children who was vaccinated was a girl Pooja with date of birth 22.7.2009. She lived with his parents Mr Gupta and Mrs Seema at No 2 Sagittarius street, Platinum, Province Yellow Location 4. Their residence phone number was +12 345 67 92 471

The same day evening, Pooja developed high fever and complained of pain at the site of injection. Her vaccinated arm started swelling. She refused to have food and started vomiting severely, she had generalised seizure at 10.30 pm, she was rushed to the Platinum Medical College Hospital at 11.00 pm. There she was examined by Dr Celine, the paediatrician of Platinum Medical College Hospital (e-mail id: celine@platinummail.com ; Phone +12 345 67 98 765) who made a diagnosis of toxic shock syndrome and admitted her to the ICU.

At 11.45 pm of **1 March 2016**, Dr Celine telephonically informed the District Immunization Officer Dr Michael Jackson who works at office of the MoH, Seaview Road, Platinum district, Province Yellow, Harmonia (email: michaeljackson@123mail.com Phone +12 543 21 67 895) about the admission of Pooja. Dr Michael Jackson promised to visit the hospital as soon as possible and told Dr Celine to assign the case number HAR-PRYE-PLAT-2016-0016 in the AEFI reporting form and initiate the AEFI reporting process. Dr Celine collected the details and completed the AEFI reporting form on **2 March 2016** at 12.30 AM. Pooja was still in the ICU and had not recovered at the time of completing the form.

Dr Michael Jackson further checked the details of the vaccination session with Ms Sadhna the new vaccinator and discovered that she had reconstituted all vials of the MR vaccine on the evening of 29 February 2016.
